to suffer by reason of such disability,

I, THEREFORE, ORDER AND DIRECT the retirement of  
said Honorable William Watts, Judge of the District Court  
of the Fourteenth Judicial District, State of Minnesota,  
for the unexpired portion of his/<sup>present</sup>term of office for which  
he was duly elected. Effective April 1, 1934.
