

RESOLUTION OF INCORPORATING VILLAGE OF GONGER

BEFORE THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS,
County of Freeborn and State of Minnesota:

The undersigned, voters and residents of the village of Gonger, Freeborn County, Minnesota, do hereby petition your Honorable Board to call an election in the village of Gonger, Alden Township, Freeborn County, Minnesota, to determine whether or not to incorporate as a village, the following lands lying in the Township of Alden, Freeborn County, Minnesota, to-wit: The Village of Gonger, in the State of Minnesota, the same as platted and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Freeborn County, Minnesota.

NOTES OF EXPLANATION

The said village of Gonger, embraces the following territory, to-wit:

Beginning at a point on the east line of section twenty-five (25), Township one hundred two (102) North, Range twenty-three (23) East, Freeborn County, Minnesota, seven hundred twenty-three (723) feet south of the north-east corner of said section twenty-five (25), thence west seven hundred fourteen (714) feet, thence north six hundred fourteen (614) feet to the south line of the Railway Right of Way, thence west two hundred eighty-six (286) feet along the Railway Right of Way line, thence north one hundred nine (109) feet to a point on the south line of section twenty-four (24), said Township and Range, said point being one thousand (1000) feet west of the southwest corner of said section twenty-four (24), thence east twenty-two (22) feet along the south line of said section twenty-four (24), thence north in said section twenty-four (24) one hundred ninety-one (191) feet, thence east thirty-six (36) feet along the north line of the Railway Right of Way, thence north five hundred forty-four and five tenths (544.5) feet, thence east nine hundred forty-two (942) feet to a point on the west line of section nineteen (19), Township one hundred two (102) North, Range twenty-two (22) East, said point being seven hundred thirty-five and five tenths (735.5) feet north of the southwest corner of said section nineteen (19), thence north one hundred eighty-nine and five tenths (189.5) feet along the west line of said section nineteen (19) thence east in said section nineteen (19) thirteen hundred fifty (1350) feet, thence south nine hundred twenty-five (925) feet to a point on the north line of section thirty (30) said Township and Range, said point being thirteen hundred fifty (1350) feet east of the north-west corner of said section thirty (30), thence west

eleven hundred forty-one and three tenths (1141.3) feet along the north line of said section thirty (30), thence south in said section thirty (30) five hundred twenty six and four tenths (526.4) feet, thence west two hundred eight and seven tenths (208.7) feet to a point on the east line of section twenty-five (25), Township one hundred two (102), North, Range twenty-three (23) East, thence south one hundred ninety-six and six tenths (196.6) feet along the east line of said section twenty-five (25) to the place of beginning, containing 81 acres.

The number of actual residents of the village of Genger, within the territory above described, on the 26th day of March, 1934, is 104.

The name of the proposed village is to be the "Village of Genger", and pray that you proceed to fix an early date for the holding of an election for such incorporation, in order that the voters residing within said territory may vote thereon.

Walk an inhabitant of said village be and hereby is appointed clerk at said election and that Robert Kruger, Otto Peterson and Charles Sprenger are appointed inspectors to act as judges in said election, and it is further directed that said election be held in accordance with law; that the inspectors of said election shall file with the County Auditor the certificate required by law; that in all things the said election shall be conducted pursuant to law.
