

RESOLUTION DISORGANIZING BROOK LAKE TOWNSHIP.

Commissioner Spencer offered the following resolution and moved its adoption:


WHEREAS, The Township of Brook Lake has less than \$50,000 assessed valuation and more than fifty per cent of its assessed valuation being delinquent and,

WHEREAS, Chapter 377, Laws of 1933, makes it mandatory upon the County Board to dissolve certain townships having less than \$50,000 valuation and a delinquency greater than fifty per cent,

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That this County Board dissolve the Town of Brook Lake and that it no longer is entitled to exercise the powers or functions of an organized township.

Resolution was seconded by Commissioner Thyren and, upon being put to vote, was unanimously carried.
