

ORDINANCE - NO. 10.

AN ORDINANCE TO EXTEND THE LIMITS OF OF THE BOUNDARIES  
OF THE VILLAGE OF BIG LAKE, SHERBURNE COUNTY, MINNESOTA.


Be it ordained by the Common Council of the Village of Big Lake:  
That on the petition of a majority of the owners of platted land  
adjoining the village of Big Lake, which plat is on file and of  
record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Sherburne  
County Minnesota, said property being described as Hazel Wood  
Park Addition and the following described property to-wit:

beginning at a point sixty (60) feet East of the South-east  
Corner of Lot One (1), Block Ten (10) of Hazel Wood Park Addition,  
thence running North Three Hundred Twenty (320) feet, thence East  
Four Hundred Twenty-Five feet (425) thence South Three Hundred  
twenty (320) feet, thence West Four Hundred Ninety five (495)  
feet to place of beginning, to be taken into the Incorporated  
Limits of the Village of Big Lake; The said petition is hereby  
granted and the boundaries of said village extended to cover said  
above described tract of land.


This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after

ORDINANCE NO. 47.

An Ordinance providing for the annexing of certain territory to the Village of Walker on petition of The M. J. Quam Company.

Whereas The M. J. Quam Company has presented to the Village Council of the Village of Walker a petition as follows:

"TO THE HONORABLE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WALKER:

"The M. J. Quam Company, a corporation, of Walker, Cass County, Minnesota, respectfully represents that it is the owner of the following described  
"unplatted land abutting upon the Village of Walker, to-wit: all that portion  
"of the South One-half ( $1/2$ ) of Section Twenty Two (22) in Township One  
"Hundred Forty Two (142) North, of Range Thirty One (31) in Cass County,  
"Minnesota, lying South of the Original Townsite of Walker, according to  
"the duly recorded plat there <sup>of</sup> on file and of record in the office of the  
"Register of Deeds of Cass County, Minnesota: described as follows, to-wit:  
"Commencing at the South East (S. E. ) corner of block Thirty Two (32) of  
"said Original Townsite of Walker, thence Westerly along the Southern bound-  
"ary of said Original Townsite of Walker, a distance of Six Hundred and  
"Seventy (670) feet to the South West corner of block Thirty Three (33) of  
"said Original Townsite of Walker, thence Southerly along the continued  
"East line of Sixth ~~(6)~~<sup>th</sup> Street in said Original Townsite of Walker, a dis-  
"tance of One Thousand Twenty Two and  $32/100$  (1022.32) feet to a Tamarack  
"stake; thence Easterly a distance of Six Hundred Seventy (670) feet to an  
"Oak stake, in a line parallel to the Southern boundary of said Original  
"Townsite of Walker, thence Northerly along the continued West line of ~~fo-~~  
"urth ~~(4)~~<sup>th</sup>, of the Original Townsite of Walker, a distance of One Thousand  
"Twenty Two and  $32/100$  (1022.32) feet to the place of begining, -save and  
"except the minerals, rocks, ores and oils upon or beneath the surface of  
"said tract.

"Said M. J. Quam Company respectfully petitions that said above tract  
"be annexed to and included within the Corporate limits of said Village of  
"Walker.

And whereas said Village Council, has by resolution duly passed, decided to grant said petition; now therefore

THE VILLAGE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WALKER DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That the following described unplatted land abutting upon the Village of Walker, to-wit: all that portion of the South One-half (S.1/2) of Section Twenty Two (22) in Township One Hundred Forty Two (142) North, of Range Thirty One (31) in Cass County, Minnesota, lying South of the Original Townsite of Walker, according to the duly recorded plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of Cass County, Minnesota; described as follows to-wit: Commencing at the South East (S.E.) corner of block Thirty Two (32) of said Original Townsite of Walker, thence Westerly along the Southern boundary of said Original Townsite of Walker, a distance of Six Hundred and Seventy (670) feet to the South West corner of block Thirty Three (33) of said Original Townsite of Walker, thence Southerly along the continued East line of Sixth ~~St~~ street in said Original Townsite of Walker, a distance of One Thousand Twenty Two and 22/100 (1022.22) feet to a Tamarack stake; thence Easterly a distance of Six Hundred Seventy (670) feet, to an Oak stake, in a line parallel to the Southern boundary of said Original Townsite of Walker, thence Northerly along the continued West line of Fourth ~~St~~ street, of the Original Townsite of Walker, a distance of One Thousand Twenty Two and 22/100 (1022.22) feet to the place of beginning, - save and except the minerals, rocks, ores and oils upon or beneath the surface of said tract, - be and the same hereby is annexed to, included within and made a part of the incorporated Village of Walker.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force from and after <sup>its</sup> ~~its~~ passage and publication and the filing of a certified copy thereof in the office of Secretary of State of Minnesota.
