In Ward No. 4 the polling place shall be in the downstairs of Niagara building at No. 217 South Central Avenue in the present Village of Chisholm.

In Ward No. 5 the polling place shall be in the basement room of Monroe School Building at the Monroe Location.

PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF CITY OF CHISHOLM

TO: THE HONORABLE MEMBERS OF THE COUNTY BOARD OF ST. LOUIS COUNTY,
MINNESOTA:

The undersigned petitioners who are citizens and voters residing in the territory proposed herein to be incorporated as the City of Chisholm, whose names are appended to this petition and the several counterparts hereof, do hereby respectfully petition your Honorable Board, state and represent as follows, to-wit:

I.

That the territory sought to be incorporated as the City of Chisholm is contiguous and is not organized as a city and has not less than 1000 inhabitants, nor more than 10,000 inhabitants.

II.

That the territory sought to be incorporated includes the territory embraced within the present Village of Chisholm, including Washington Addition thereto, which is situated on the Southwest quarter of the southeast quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$) in Section sixteen (16), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20), and in addition thereto the following territory adjacent and contiguous to said Village of Chisholm, all being situated in Township fifty-eight (58), and Range twenty (20), as follows, to-wit: Carlin's Second Addition to Chisholm, situated on the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$), of Section sixteen (16); Carlin Gardens being situated on the northeast quarter of the southwest quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said section sixteen (16); and Garden Lands being situated on the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section sixteen (16), and the southwest quarter of the southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said section sixteen (16); the southeast quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section seventeen (17); the east half of the northeast quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$) and the east half ($E\frac{1}{2}$) of the southeast quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$), of Section twenty (20); the east half of the northeast quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$) and the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$) and the south half of the southwest quarter ($S\frac{1}{2}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$), all in Section twenty-nine (29); the north half of the northwest quarter ($N\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$) and the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$), in

Section thirty-two (32); all of Section thirty-three (33); the entire west half ($W\frac{1}{2}$) and the entire northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section thirty-four (34); all of Section twenty-seven (27) not previously included in the Village of Chisholm (which portion included in the Village of Chisholm previously is the southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of the northwest quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$); the northwest quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of section thirty-five (35); and the southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$); the south half of the northwest quarter ($S\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$), and the northeast ^{quarter} ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty-six (26)---all being in Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20), St. Louis County, Minnesota. The said territory sought to be incorporated into the City of Chisholm is all contiguous and is properly subject for municipal government as a City of the Fourth Class, and is situated and described by metes and bounds as follows, to-wit: commencing at the northeast corner of Section twenty-two (22), in Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20), St. Louis County, Minnesota, thence going west along the north section line of Sections twenty-two and (22) and twenty-one (21), to a point on the north section line of section twenty-one (21), being the northwest corner of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$), of said section twenty-one (21), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20); thence north along the east boundary line of the west half of the southeast quarter ($W\frac{1}{2}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$), of Section sixteen (16), to the northeast corner of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$), of said Section sixteen (16) in Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20); thence west along the north boundary line of the northwest quarter of the southeast quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$), and along the north boundary line of the southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section sixteen (16), and continuing along the north boundary line of the Southeast quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section seventeen (17), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20), to the center of Section seventeen (17); thence south along the west boundary line of the southeast quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section seventeen (17), to the southwest corner of said southeast quarter/^($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section seventeen (17); thence east along the south section line of section seventeen (17), to the southeast corner of the southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said southeast quarter

(SE $\frac{1}{4}$) in Section seventeen (17); thence south along the west boundary line of the east half of the northeast quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$), and of the east half of the southeast quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$), in Section twenty (20) and continuing south along the west boundary line of the east half of the northeast quarter (E $\frac{1}{2}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of section twenty-nine (29), and south along the west boundary line of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section twenty-nine (29), to the southwest corner of the northeast quarter of said southeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$), in Section twenty-nine (29); thence west along the north boundary line of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) and continuing along the north boundary line of the south half (S $\frac{1}{2}$) of the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$), to the west section line of said section twenty-nine (29); thence south along the west section line of Sections twenty-nine and thirty-two (29 and 32) to the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of the northwest quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section thirty-two (32), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20); thence east along the south boundary line of the north half of the northwest quarter (N $\frac{1}{2}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$), and east along the south boundary of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$), in said section thirty-two (32), to the southeast corner of said northwest quarter of the northeast quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section thirty-two (32); thence north along the east boundary of said northwest quarter of the northeast quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$) to the north section line of said section thirty-two (32); thence east along the north section line of said Section thirty-two (32), to the northeast corner of said Section thirty-two (32); thence south along the east boundary line of said Section thirty-two (32) to the southeast corner of said Section thirty-two (32); thence east along the south section line of Sections thirty-three (33) and thirty-four (34), to the southeast corner of the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section thirty-four (34), in Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20); thence north along the east boundary line of the southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section thirty-four (34); to the center of Section thirty-four

(34); thence east along the south boundary line of the northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of said section thirty-four (34), and continuing east along the south boundary line of the northwest quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section thirty-five (35), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20), to the center of said Section thirty-five (35); thence north along the east boundary line of the northwest quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section thirty-five (35), and continuing north along the east boundary line of the southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty-six (26), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20), to the center of said Section twenty-six (26); thence east along the south boundary line of the northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of said section twenty-six (26) to the east section line of said Section twenty-six (26); thence north along the east section line of said Section twenty-six (26) to the northeast corner of said section; thence west along the north section line of said Section twenty-six (26) in Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20), to the northwest corner of the northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section twenty-six (26); thence south along the west boundary line of the northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty-six (26) to the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of the northeast quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section twenty-six (26); thence west along the south boundary line of the north half of the northwest quarter ($N\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section twenty-six (26), to the west section line of Section twenty-six (26); thence north along the east section line of Sections twenty-seven (27) and twenty-two (22) to the northeast corner of the southeast quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section twenty-two (22), in Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20); thence east along the south boundary of the northwest quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty-three (23), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20), to the center of said Section twenty-three (23); thence north along the east boundary line of said northwest quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section twenty-three (23) to the northeast corner of the southeast quarter of the northwest quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section twenty-three; thence west along the north boundary line of the south half of the northwest quarter ($S\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section twenty-three (23) to the west section line of said Section twenty-three (23); thence

north along the west section line of said Section twenty-three (23) to the point of beginning;--which territory, when incorporated as a city of the Fourth Class, shall be known and named as the City of Chisholm.

III.

That the said proposed City of Chisholm shall be divided into five wards to be numbered and to have metes and bounds as follows, to-wit:

WARD NO. I. Commencing at the intersection of the center lines of Third Avenue and Lake Street in the present Village of Chisholm, St. Louis County, Minnesota, thence going north along the center line of said Third Avenue to the point of intersection of said center line of Third Avenue with the north section line of Section twenty-one (21), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20), thence east along the north section line of said Section twenty-one (21), to the southeast corner of the southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$), Section sixteen (16), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20), thence north along the east boundary line of the Southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section sixteen (16), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20), to the center of said Section sixteen (16); thence west along the north boundary line of the southwest quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section sixteen (16); and continuing west along the north boundary line of the southeast quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section seventeen (17), to the center of said section seventeen (17), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20); thence south along the west boundary line of said southeast quarter ($SE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section seventeen (17) to the south section line of said section seventeen (17); thence east along the south section line of said section seventeen (17), to the southeast corner of the southwest quarter of the southeast quarter ($SW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section seventeen (17); thence south along the west boundary of the east half of the northeast quarter ($E\frac{1}{2}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty-(20) in Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20), and continuing south along the west boundary line of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$) of

said Section twenty (20), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20) to the point of intersection of the center line of the old right-of-way of the former Mesaba Electric Railway Company, commonly known as the Mesaba Interurban Line with the west boundary line of said northeast quarter of the southeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$), of Section twenty (20), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20); thence easterly along the center line of said right-of-way, across the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $SE\frac{1}{4}$), of Section twenty (20), and across the northwest quarter of the southwest quarter ($NW\frac{1}{4}$ of $SW\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty-one (21), and along said center line of said right-of-way, and along Lake Street in the present Village of Chisholm to the point of beginning--which territory so included shall be known as Ward No. I.

WARD NO. II. Commencing at the point of intersection of the center lines of Lake Street and Second Avenue in the present Village of Chisholm, St. Louis County, Minnesota, thence going south along the center line of said Second Avenue, to the point of intersection with the north section line of Section twenty-eight (28); thence east along the north section line of Section twenty-eight (28), to the northeast corner of said section twenty-eight (28), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20), thence south along the east section line of said Section twenty-eight (28), to the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$) of said section twenty-eight (28); thence west along the south boundary line of the North half ($N\frac{1}{2}$) of said northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$), and along the south boundary line of the north half of the northwest quarter ($N\frac{1}{2}$ of $NW\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section twenty-eight (28), and continuing west along the south boundary line of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$) of Section twenty-nine (29), Township fifty-eight (58), Range twenty (20), to the southwest corner of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$) of said Section twenty-nine, (29), thence north along the west boundary line of the northeast quarter of the northeast quarter ($NE\frac{1}{4}$ of $NE\frac{1}{4}$), of said Section twenty-nine, and continuing north along the west boundary line of the

east half of the southeast quarter of Section twenty (20), to the point of intersection with the center line of the old right-of-way of the Mesaba Electric Railway Company, commonly known as the Mesaba Interurban Line above referred to; thence easterly along the center line of said right-of-way, and along the center line of Lake Street in the present Village of Chisholm to the point of beginning--which territory so included shall be known as Ward No. II.

WARD NO. III. That your petitioner and the undersigned voters have executed this petition for the incorporation of the City of Chisholm as a City of the Fourth Class in several counter-parts, all of which are to be considered and treated as originals and as a part of one instrument and petition, to be filed with the County Auditor of St. Louis County, State of Minnesota.

VIII.

That this petition for the incorporation of the City of Chisholm as a City of the Fourth Class has been signed by more than one-fourth of the number of legal qualified voters, residing in the territory proposed to be incorporated as a city that voted in said territory at the last and preceding general election for state offices.


