The undersigned petitioners respectfully represent:

I.

That they, and each of them, are legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described as territory sought to be annexed and to become a part of said Village of Buhl.

II.

Said petitioners herewith respectfully petition and request the Village Council of said Village of Buhl to call an election for the determination of the annexation to said Village of Buhl of the hereinafter described territory, which territory is not included in any incorporated city or village and no part of which is more than one and one-half miles from the present limits of said Village of Buhl, but all of which adjoins thereto.

III.

That the territory so proposed to be annexed is described as follows, to wit:

RESOLUTIONS.

WHEREAS, Upon the 2nd. day of August, 1909, a petition was duly made, presented to, and filed with, the Village Council of the Village of Buhl, St. Louis County, Minnesota, which petition was signed by five of the legal voters residing in the territory described in said petition, and which petition requests said Village Council to call an election for the determination of the proposed annexation to said Village of Buhl, of certain territory described in said petition.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, By the Village Council of the Village of Buhl:

That an election be called, and the same is hereby called, for the determination of the annexation to said Village of Buhl of the territory described in said petition.

That the time of holding said election shall be, and the same is so hereby fixed, on Wednesday, the 18th. day of August, 1909, and the polls shall be kept open from nine o'clock in the afternoon to five o'clock on the afternoon of said day.
