Director of Game and Fish that deer are in danger of undue
depletion in the County of Itasca, State of Minnesota, and


Whereas, the Director of Game and Fish has
investigated and has presented me with the results of his
investigation and has recommended that additional protection
be given deer in Itasca County, to prevent their undue de-
pletion;

Now, therefore, I, Floyd B. Olson, Governor
of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of and pursuant to author-
ity in me vested by Section 5640, G. S. 1923, do hereby order
that no doe or fawn be taken in the County of Itasca, State of
Minnesota, during the season of 1934.

This order shall remain in force until the
close of the 1935 regular Session of the Legislature of the State
of Minnesota, unless sooner revoked or modified.
