GOVERNOR'S ORDER NUMBER 12, EXTENDING ADDITIONAL PROTECTION  
TO RACCOON IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA DURING THE YEAR 1934

Whereas, it has been represented to the Director of Game and Fish that raccoon are in danger of undue depletion in the State of Minnesota, and

Whereas, the Director of Game and Fish has investigated and has presented me with the results of his investigation and has recommended that protection be given raccoon in all of the counties in the State of Minnesota, during the year 1934, to prevent their undue depletion.

Now, therefore, I, Floyd B. Olson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of and pursuant to authority vested in me by Section 5640, G. S. 1923, do hereby order that raccoon may be taken in all of the counties in the State of Minnesota, in the manner and under the conditions prescribed by law, between the dates of November 10th and December 1st, 1934, both dates inclusive.
