## ORDINANCE NO 35

AN ORDINANCE ADMEXING CERTAIN ADJACENT LAND TO THE VILLAGE OF GREEN ISLE, MINNESOTA.

The Village Council of the Village of Green Isle, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

## Section I.

That the following described land, to-wit: Beginning at a point on the South boundary line of Cleveland Avenue as same is platted and laid out and shown on the plat of McGrann's Third Addition to the Village of Green Isle and Fitzpatrick's Addition to the Village of Green Isle, according to the plats of said additions on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for Sibley County, Minnesota, which point is 396 feet Westerly of the Northwest Corner of Lot One (1), of BAOEK Five (5) in Fitzpatrick's Addition aforesaid, thence running Southerly, parallel with the East line of said Block Five (5) of Fitzpatrick's Addition aforesaid 132 feet, thence running Westerly parallel with the Southerly line of said Cleveland Avenue aforesaid, 132 feet, thence running Northerly, parallel with said East line of Block Five (5) Fitzpatrick's Addition as aforesaid, 132 feet to the Southerly line of said Cleveland Avenue, and thence running Easterly along said Southerly line of Cleveland Avenue 132 feet to the place of beginning. All being in the South helf of the Southwest Quarter, Section Eighteen, Township One Hundred Fourteen, Range Twenty-six, Sibley County, Minnesota; abutting upon the incorporated Village, and shall become a part of said Village as effectually as if said land had been originally a part thereof.

## Section 2.

This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after its adoption and publication, and a certified copy duly filed with the County Additor and the Secretary of State, as provided by law.
