WHEREAS, The Hon. Norman E.Peterson, Judge of the District Court in and for Freeborn County, in the Tenth Judicial District, has been disqualified, by an affidavit of prejudice filed, to act as Judge in the trial of the case of State vs. Ray Hemenway et al, set for trial in said Freeborn County in said District on February 11th, 1935; and

WHEREAS, in my judgment, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, the convenience and interest of the public and the interest of said defendant requires that a Judge of another Judicial District shall discharge the duties of such Judge and try and determine all matters therein.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Floyd B. Olson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate and appoint the Hon. Fred Senn, Judge of the District Court in the Fifth Judicial District, to discharge the duties of the Hon. Norman E.Peterson, Judge of the District Court in the Tenth Judicial District, and preside at the trial of the State vs. Ray Hemenway et al at the Court House at Albert Lea, Minnesota, in the District Court of Freeborn County, in the Tenth Judicial District on February 11, 1935, commencing at ten o'clock in the morning, or at such other time as may be designated therefor.


