

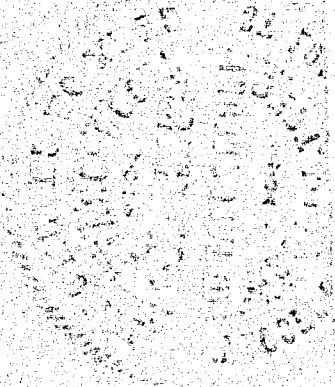

RESOLUTION FOR SPECIAL CENSUS

WHEREAS the Village of Chisholm in the County of St. Louis and State of Minnesota was duly incorporated as a city of the fourth class on September 1, 1934 under the name and title of the City of Chisholm and

WHEREAS such incorporation as City of Chisholm include all of the territory of said former Village of Chisholm, and other territory in addition thereto and

WHEREAS there is no census of said newly established city of Chisholm and

WHEREAS it is very essential that a census be taken of the population of said City of Chisholm to determine the per capita limitation of taxes and

WHEREAS Section 4 of Ch. 417 Laws of 1921 provide for the taking of special census by the Secretary of the State.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Chisholm at a regular meeting duly held this 12th day of December, 1934, that a special census of the City of Chisholm be taken as provided in said Sec. 4 of Ch. 417 Laws of 1921 by the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota that said Secretary of State be hereby petitioned to cause said census to be taken at once and completed prior to January 1, 1935 and that a certified copy of this resolution be forthwith sent to said Secretary of State.

I, Walter B. Brown, first being duly sworn, depose and say:

Prior to December 14, 1934, this deponent was duly appointed by the secretary of state of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to Chapter 417, Laws of 1921 as supervisor of census, and

W. Bero, all of the City of Chisholm

and State of Minnesota, were duly appointed by said secretary of state, pursuant to said act, as enumerators of the census, and this deponent and the nineteen above mentioned enumerators were directed by the Secretary of State aforesaid to take a census of the residents of The City of Chisholm, St. Louis County, Minnesota.

That, thereafter, this deponent and said enumerators agreed in writing and under oath to perform their duties in connection with said census faithfully and impartially and under the direction of said secretary of state, as more fully appears from Exhibits A, B, C, D, and E, hereto attached and made a part hereof.

That between the dates of December 14 and December 29, 1934, all of the inhabitants of said City were personally interviewed by one of the 19 enumerators above mentioned, working under deponent's supervision; that a separate card was prepared for each of the residents of said district, containing the name of

such resident, and also containing other data, required by the secretary of state; that these cards were prepared by said enumerators under the direction of this deponent and said cards have been duly filed with said Secretary of State; that the facts stated on said cards are true and reference is hereby made thereto for that purpose.

That, as a result of said census, it appears that there were on December 29, 1934, Eight Thousand Six Hundred & ¹ Party-eight residents (8648) of said City.

That, after the enumeration of the inhabitants of said City each of the nineteen above mentioned enumerators and this deponent executed an affidavit to the effect that the facts stated in said cards were true. Said affidavits were hereto attached and made a part hereof and marked Exhibits "F. G. H. I., and J".

Further, affiant sayeth not, save that this affidavit is made for the secretary of state of Minnesota to be filed in his office as a report of the results of the census of the inhabitants of said City, made by this deponent under his direction.

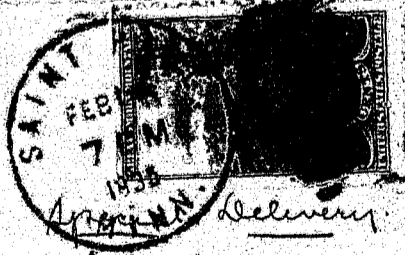

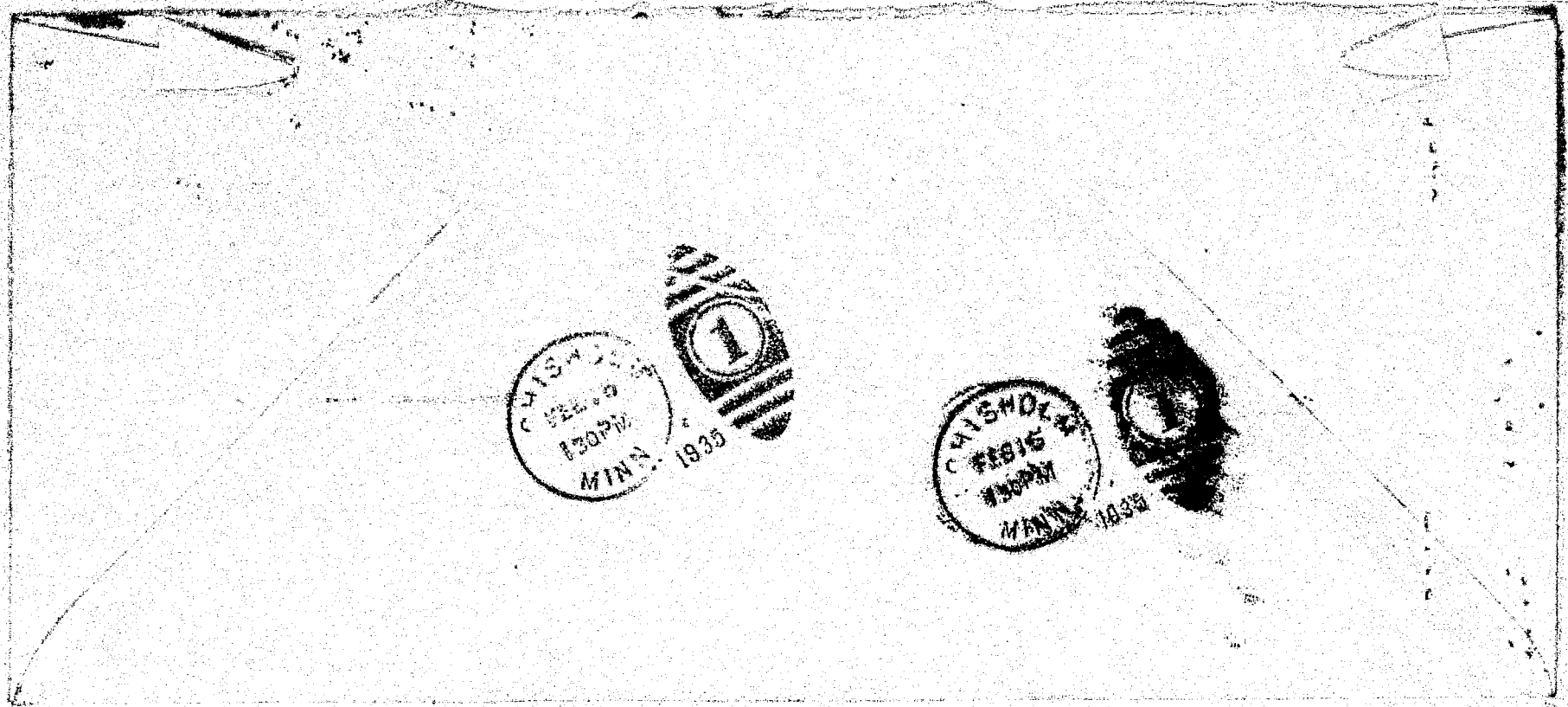
