

WHEREAS at a special village election duly held at the village hall in the village of Hinckley, in the county of Pine and state of Minnesota, on the 2nd day of November, 1909, to vote on the question whether such village of Hinckley shall continue to exist under the General Statutes of 1894, and amendments thereto, or shall become re-incorporated under Chapter 9, Revised Laws, 1905, the following number of votes, as canvassed by us, were cast for and against said proposition to reincorporate, to-wit:
