An Ordinance Extending the Present Boundaries of the Village of Biwabik and Annexing to said Village Certain Land Commonly known as the Wm. Smith Property.

The Village Council of the Village of Biwabik, in Saint Louis County, Minnesota, do ordain as follows:

with Section 707 of the Revised Laws of Minnesota, 1905, the present corporate limits and village boundaries of the Village of Biwabik, St. Louis County, Minnesota, are hereby extended so as to include all that piece and parcel of land outlined, bounded and described in Section 2 hereof and the same is hereby annexed to, declared to be an addition to, and a part of the Village of Biwabik as effectually as if the same had been originally a part thereof.

SECTION II. Description of Property. --- The land hereby annexed being adjacent to and abutting upon the present corporate limits of the Village of Biwabik is described as follows;
