



PETITION FOR INCORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF ORR

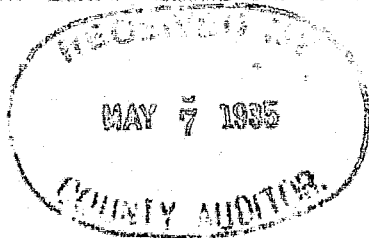
TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, ST. LOUIS  
COUNTY, MINNESOTA

We, the undersigned voters residing in the territory hereinafter described, hereby petition your honorable body to call an election for the submission to the voters of such territory of the question of whether or not the said territory shall be incorporated as a village under the name of "Village of Orr", such incorporation to be in accordance with the general laws of the State of Minnesota for the incorporation of villages.

In furtherance of such petition, your petitioners represent that the territory proposed to be incorporated in said Village is described as follows, to-wit:

Lots 3, 4, and 5, and the Northeast Quarter of the Southeast Quarter ( $NE\frac{1}{4}$  of  $SE\frac{1}{4}$ ) in Section Thirty-one (31), and the Southwest Quarter of Section Thirty-two (32), all in Township Sixty-five (65), Range Nineteen (19); Lots 1, 4, 5 and 8 in Section One (1), Lot 1 in Section Twelve, all in Township Sixty-four (64) Range Twenty (20); Lots 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7, and the East One-half ( $E\frac{1}{2}$ ) of the Southwest Quarter ( $SW\frac{1}{4}$ ) and the Southeast of the Northwest Quarter ( $SE$  of  $NW\frac{1}{4}$ ) in Section Six (6), all in Township Sixty-four (64) Range Nineteen (19); Lot 1 and the Northeast of the Northwest ( $NE$  of  $NW$ ) of Section Seven (7), Township Sixty-four (64) Range Nineteen (19), St. Louis County, Minnesota, all of said lands being described by meets and bounds as follows:

That of the lands above described, Lot Four (4) in Section One (1), Township Sixty-four (64) Range Twenty (20), colored in pink on Exhibit A, has been platted into lots and blocks and the plat thereof duly and legally certified according to the laws of the State of Minnesota and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of St. Louis County, Minnesota, which plat is known as "Pelican Beach".

That of the lands above described, Lot Five (5) in Section Six (6), Township Sixty-four (64) Range Nineteen (19), colored in red on Exhibit A, has been platted into lots and blocks and the plat thereof duly and legally certified according to the laws of the State of Minnesota and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds of St. Louis County, Minnesota, which plat is known as "Lake End".

That the other lands so proposed to be incorporated in said village adjoin said platted portions thereof and are so conditioned as properly to be subject to village government and contain no known minerals; that the lands in the territory proposed to be incorporated as "VILLAGE OF ORR" be constituted a separate election and assessment district.

That your petitioners have caused a census of the resident population of said territory to be taken and that said census was taken on the 27th day of April, 1935, and said census revealed that the number of actual residents in said proposed territory to be incorporated number 194, a copy of which census is hereto attached and marked "Exhibit B".

That the name of the proposed village is "Village of Orr".



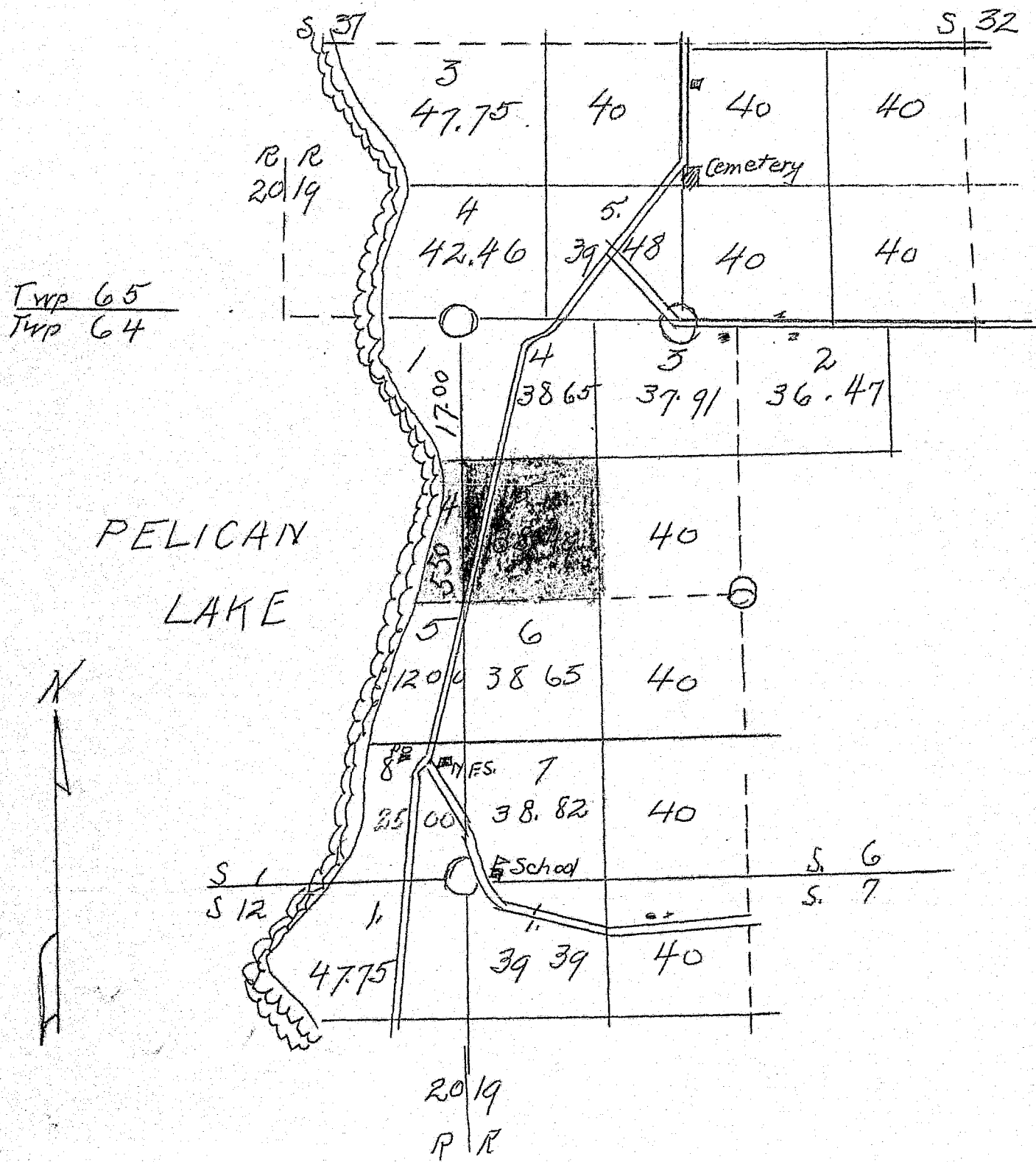
