WHEREAS, in my judgment, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, the convenience and interest of the public and the interest of said defendant requires that a Judge of another Judicial District shall discharge the duties of such Judge and try and determine all matters therein;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Floyd D. Olson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate and appoint the Hon. W. A. Schultz, Judge of the District Court in the First Judicial District, to discharge the duties of the Hon. G. E. Swale, Judge of the District Court in the Twelfth Judicial District, and preside at the trial of Wilson vs. City of Montevideo at the Court House at Montevideo, Minnesota, in the Twelfth Judicial District on June 17th, 1935, commencing at ten o'clock in the morning, or at such other time as may be designated therefor.
