STATE OF MINHESOTA EXECUTIVE DEPARTMENT ST. PAUL GOVERNOY'S ORDER NO. 13

WRIT AND PROCLAMATION CONCERNING THE TAKING AND SALE OF BULLHEADS IN CERTAIN COUNTIES AND IN THE STATE OF MINNESOTA

To the people of the State of Minnesota; to the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota; to the Law Enforcement Officers of the Conservation Department of the State of Minnesota; and to all others whom it may concern: GREETINGS:

Director of Game and Fish with reference to providing necessary (and adequate protection for the propagation of bullheads with reference to the commercial fishing and trafficking in bullheads in Ottertall and Becker Counties and in the State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, it having been found that there is denger of undue depletion of such fish by a continuence of such fishing, marketing and trafficking in aforesaid counties, and

UHEREAS, this order is imminently necessary for the immediate protection of the bullheads and other fish found in the lakes and streams of aforesaid counties and other parts of the State of Minnesota,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Floyd B. Olson, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, hereby order and proclaim that pursuant to the authority of the provisions of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 5640 and in conformance to the provisions of Section 5580 of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, that under penalties prescribed by law no person shall take bullheads from the waters of Ottertall and Becker counties in any manner whatsoever for commercial purposes, or in any of the waters of this state other than by angling and no person shall take in one day or have in possession at any time more than thirty (30) bullheads, provided, however that nothing in this proclamation contained shall restrict the power of the Division of Game and Fish or the Commissioner of Conservation, after due investigation and report thereof in writing filed in the Division of Game and Fish, to take necessary steps for the conservation and propagation of the fish in any of the waters of Minnesota.

Provided, that the provisions of this order shall not apply to Le Sueur or Rice Counties, or to boundary waters of this state.

FURTHERMORE, that this order shall take effect from and after the date hereof and shall remain in effect and be in force until revoked.
