WRIT OF ELECTION TO FILL VACANCY IN THE
OFFICE OF STATE SENATOR FROM THE TWENTY-
SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT OF THE STATE,
AND OF SPECIAL PRIMARY ELECTION TO NOMI-
NATE CANDIDATES FOR SAID OFFICE.

To the People of the State of Minnesota, and particularly
of the Twenty-second Senatorial District of said State;
to the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota;
to the County Auditor of the County of McLeod of said
State; to all Election Officials of said Twenty-second
Senatorial District and of the several Election Districts
therein; and to all Others Whom it may Concern - GREETING:

WHEREAS, a vacancy now exists in the office of state
senator from the twenty-second senatorial district of the State
of Minnesota, caused by the death of the late state senator,
the Honorable H. H. Bonniwell; and

WHEREAS, there will be occasion for the person
elected to fill said vacancy to take office and to exercise
the functions thereof before the opening of the next regular
session of the state legislature;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Floyd B. Olson, as Governor of
the State of Minnesota, acting under the authority and di-
rection of Section 17 of Article IV of the Constitution of
this state and the statutes in such case provided, do hereby
direct that a special election to fill said vacancy be held
in said district on Monday, the twenty-first day of October,
1935; that a special primary election for the nomination of
candidates for said vacancy be held in said district on Monday,
the fourteenth day of October, 1935; that the affidavits of candi-


dates for nomination at said primary be filed not later than the seventh day before said primary, to-wit, not later than Monday, the seventh day of October, 1955; that notices of said election and the special primary therefor, the nomination and election of candidates, and the conduct of said elections be had, and all things pertaining thereto be done, as provided by Laws 1929, Chapter 297, and amendments thereof, and other applicable provisions of law.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto caused the Great Seal of the state to be affixed, and have hereunto set my hand at the Capitol, in the City of St. Paul, Minnesota, this 24th day of September, 1955.
