We, those names are undersigned, respectfully petition your Honorable Board to fix a time and place when and where the electors actually residing upon the lands hereinafter described may vote for or against the incorporation of a Village embracing the territory described therein and to be named the Village of Lake Fremont and containing a population of Two Hundred People actually residing therein as shown by a census by W. R. Hurtt, Fay Bowles and Joseph E. Cahoes. On the 30th day of December, 1909, less than eight weeks previous to the present date, said territory to be so incorporated being described as follows, to wit:-

The South half (S  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section Eight (8) and nine (9) and the North half (N  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) of Section sixteen (16) and seventeen (17), in Township 34 Thirty-four, of Range twenty six (26), in Sherburne County, State of Minnesota, according to the plat of said proposed Village now on file in the office of the Register of Deeds of said Sherburne County.

Minnesota, the following Resolution was adopted:-


Resolved, that Saturday the 29th day of January A. D.






