PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the Board of Managers of the Minnesota Congress of Parents and Teachers have voted the month of October as membership and enrollment month for the State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, at the present time the attention of all people is focused upon social and economic problems, the solution of which depends, in part, upon our schools and the extent to which we care for the youth of the land, the citizens of tomorrow, and

WHEREAS, the effectiveness of the schools will depend in a large part not only upon a fearless, intelligent, public-spirited group of men and women in education but also upon the courageous and intelligent support of the schools and education by all citizens of this country, and

WHEREAS, the Parent-Teachers Organizations of this country provide an instrument through which the support of people for the schools may be articulated and brought to bear upon the problem of the schools,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Floyd B. Olson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, hereby proclaim the month of October of this year as the particular month in which attention shall be given to mobilizing all citizens of this State to the support of all efforts of the Parent-Teachers Organizations that are directed toward the serious consideration of all problems that surround education for democracy to the end that the objectives for education in the maintenance and extension of the privileges and opportunities of a democratic government may be achieved.
