

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, Harry H. Peterson, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the provisions of Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927, Section 114, do hereby constitute and appoint Arthur W. McMillan of Minneapolis, Minnesota, as Special Counsel for the Minnesota State Board of Control for the express and sole purpose of collecting for the State of Minnesota the amount of money devised to the said State for the Benefit of the Schools for the Deaf and Blind at Faribault, Minnesota by Mary E. Hancarrow and for said purpose to represent the State of Minnesota in the filing of a fire claim for damages resulting from the fire of October 13, 1918 with the United States government.

I hereby fix the compensation of the said Arthur W. McMillan at ten (10) per cent of the amount collected from the United States government, said compensation to be paid from the appropriations made to the State Board of Control. Said appointment shall commence on the date of this certificate and shall continue until notice of termination thereof by the appointing officer.
