

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I, Harry H. Peterson, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 114, Mason's Minnesota Statutes for 1927, do hereby constitute and appoint E. P. Lee to be a Special Assistant Attorney General for the Commissioner of Highways, and I hereby fix his compensation in the sum of \$250 per month to be paid from and out of the Trunk Highway Fund. Said appointment to commence on August 1, 1935, and ending the first Monday in January, 1937, unless sooner removed.
