The Minister of Greece presents his compliments to His Excellency the Secretary of State and has the honor to bring to his attention that, in conformity with the laws of the State of Minnesota, lawyers in various cities of that state, wishing to deliver documents concerning inheritance cases involving persons living in Greece, have addressed those documents to the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota so he may deliver them, in conformity with the law, to the proper Greek Consular Officers.

It appears that the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, instead of forwarding these papers to the Consul General of Greece at Chicago, under whose jurisdiction the State of Minnesota comes, has addressed these documents to this Legation, from where they must be retransmitted to Chicago.
