

ORDINANCE NO. 117

An ordinance extending boundaries of the Village of Kilkenny, County of LeSueur, and State of Minnesota.

The Village Council, of the Village of Kilkenny, do ordain, as follows:

Sec. 1. That the Village boundaries of said Village of Kilkenny are hereby extended so as to include

the following land, to-wit: Commencing at a point on the south line of Knappa addition to Kilkenny (according to the plat of said addition which is on file and of record in the office of the Register of deeds within and for said County), where said line intersects the right of way of the Minneapolis and St. Louis Railroad company, on the west line of said right of way and being in sec. 27-110-23, thence running west on said line 102 feet, thence due south 80 feet, thence due east 102 feet, to the right of way of said railroad Co, thence running north along the west line of right of way of said Railroad Co, a distance of 80 feet to the place of beginning, and being a strip 80 feet north and south and 102 feet east and west.

Sec. 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.
