ORDINANCE No. 60

An Ordinance to Extend the Boundaries of the Village of Stephen and incorporate additional territory therein.

The Village Council of Stephen, Minnesota do ordain:

Section 1. Village Boundaries Extended.

Pursuant to a petition duly signed by a majority of the owners of land abutting upon the Village of Stephen described as: The Riverside Subdivision of Section Five of the Town of Tamarac, Marshall County, Minnesota according to the plat thereof on file in the Register of Deeds office within and for the said County, totaling thirty two and thirtym one-one hundredths (32.31) acres, the territorial limits of this Village are hereby extended to include the aforesaid territory within its limits and the aforesaid lands shall hereafter be a part of the Village and shall be governed as other territory of the Village is governed.

Section 2. Copy to be filed with the Register of Deeds and Secretary of State.

The Village Clerk is directed to forward certified copy of this ordinance to the Register of Deeds of Marshall County, and to the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota.

Section 3. Effect.

The aforesaid territory shall be annexed to the Village upon the adoption hereof.


