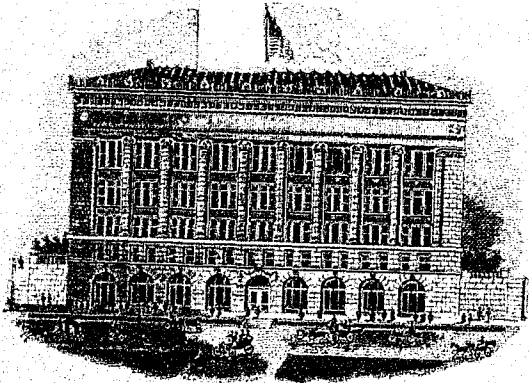

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN, That on Saturday, the 2nd day of APRIL, 1910, pursuant to an order of the County Board of St. Louis County, Minnesota, an election will be held at and in the room occupied by Mike Rudell, in the building known as his residence on First Avenue, in the Western Addition to the Village of Hibbing, said building being a structure within the limits of said territory so proposed to be incorporated, ("ALICE", Sections 12 and 13, Township 57 North, Range 21 West), for the purpose of determining whether the territory bounded as follows:

Commencing at the northeast corner of Section 12, Township 57 North, Range 21 West, to the southeast corner of Section 13, Township 57 North, Range 21 West, a distance of two miles more or less; thence West along the south boundary line of said Section 13, being a distance of one mile more or less; thence North along the west boundary of said Section 13 to the west boundary line of Section 12, Township 57 North, Range 21 West, to the northwest corner of said Section 12, being a distance of two miles more or less; thence East along the north boundary line of said Section 12 a distance of one mile more or less to the point of beginning, embracing one thousand two hundred and eighty (1280) acres of land.

Shall be incorporated as a Village under Chapter 9, Revised Laws of Minnesota for the year 1905, and amendments thereto. The polls of said election will be open from ¹⁰~~8~~ a.m. to ⁴~~3~~ p.m. on said day and only qualified electors actually resident within said boundaries shall be entitled to vote.

M. D. McMillan, A. L. Baudett, and Samuel Pritchard, residents of said territory are hereby appointed Inspectors and shall act as Judges of said election.

By Commissioner Ryan:

Whereas a certain petition for incorporating the Village of Alice has been duly presented to the Board of County Commissioners in and for the County of St. Louis, State of Minnesota, it being shown by said petition that it is desired to incorporate certain tracts of land in said County, not already incorporated, to-wit: The NE 1/4 of the NE 1/4, and the SE 1/4 of the NE 1/4, and the NE 1/4 of the SE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 57 North, Range 21 West, according to the United States Government Survey thereof, which has been wholly platted into lots and blocks, and upon other lands adjacent thereto desired to be incorporated in the County of St. Louis and State of Minnesota, and not in any incorporated village, which said plats have been duly certified according to the laws of this State, and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds in said County, to-wit: Commencing at the northeast corner of Section 13, Township 57 North, Range 21 West, to the southeast corner of said last named Section 13, Township 57 North, Range 21 West, a distance of two miles more or less; thence West along the south boundary line of said Section 13, being a distance of one mile more or less; thence North along the west boundary of said Section 13 to the west boundary line of Section 12, Township 57 North, Range 21 West, to the northwest corner of said Section 12, being a distance of two miles more or less; thence East along the North boundary line of said Section 12 a distance of one mile more or less to the point of beginning, embracing 1280 acres of land. And WHEREAS it is further shown by said petition among other things that a census of said territory so proposed to be incorporated has been duly taken and that the census discloses a population of more than 200 persons residents upon said territory so proposed to be incorporated, and WHEREAS it is further recited by said petition that said tracts of land are so conditioned as properly to be subject to Village Government, and WHEREAS it is true that said petition has been duly signed by the required number of voters residing within said territory, and further that all of the requirements of the Statutes in such case made and provided have been duly complied with on the part of said petition-

ers, and in the instance of their said petition,

NOW, THEREFORE, after duly considering said petition and all of the facts in connection therewith, be it and it hereby is RESOLVED, That said petition be approved and the prayer thereof granted, and further that the election prayed for in said petition be and the same hereby is ordered to be held on Saturday, the 2nd day of April, 1910, at and in the room occupied by Mike Rudell, in the building known as his residence on First Avenue, in the Western Addition to the Village of Hibbing, said building being a structure within the limits of said territory so proposed to be incorporated, and further that M. D. McMillan, A. L. Baudett, and Samuel Pritchard, be and the same are hereby appointed as inspectors who shall act as Judges at said election and conduct the same as far as practicable, according to the laws regulating the election of Town Officers, and that the County Auditor in and for the said County of St. Louis be and he hereby is instructed and directed to cause proper notice of said petition to be made and the same to be posted in three public places within the boundaries of the territory described in said petition and proposed to be incorporated, together with a notice attached to each of said copies, and which said notice shall state the time and place of holding said election, pursuant to the determination of the Board of County Commissioners as to said time and place made by this resolution.

Commissioner Ryan moved the adoption of the resolution, and it was declared adopted upon the following vote: Yeas, Commissioners Fraser, Tischer, Cumming, McMahan, Overton, Ryan and Chairman McInnis, 7. Nays, none.

The undersigned twenty-five or more electors, residents from the following described lands, to-wit: The Northeast one fourth (NE 1/4) of the Northeast one fourth (NE 1/4), and the Southeast one fourth of the Northeast one fourth (SE 1/4 of NE 1/4), and the Northeast one fourth of the Southeast one fourth (NE 1/4 of SE 1/4), of Section thirteen (13), Township fifty-seven (57) North, Range twenty-one (21) West, according to the United States Government Survey thereof, which have been wholly platted into lots and blocks, and upon other lands adjacent thereto, desired to be incorporated, in the County of St. Louis, State of Minnesota, and not in any incorporated Village, which said plats have been duly certified according to the laws of this State, and filed in the office of the Register of Deeds, in said St. Louis County, to-wit: Commencing at the Northeast corner of section twelve (12), Township fifty-seven (57) North, Range twenty-one (21) West, thence South along the East boundary line of said Sec. twelve (12), and East boundary line of Section thirteen, (13), Township fifty-seven (57) North, Range twenty-one (21) West, to the Southeast corner of said last named Section thirteen (13), Township fifty-seven (57), North, Range twenty-one (21), West, a distance of two miles more or less; thence West along the South boundary line of said section thirteen (13), to the Southwest corner of said section thirteen (13), being a distance of one mile more or less; thence North along the West boundary line of said section thirteen (13), and West boundary line of section twelve (12), Township fifty-seven (57), North, Range twenty-one (21), West, to the Northwest corner of said section twelve (12), being a distance of two miles more or less; thence East along the North boundary line of said section twelve (12), a distance of one mile more or less to point of beginning, embracing one thousand two hundred and eighty acres of land (1280), and having a resident population of two hundred and twenty-three (223), hereby petition your Honorable Body, The Board of County Commissioners of St. Louis County, Minnesota, to appoint a time and place when and where the electors actually residing upon said lands may vote for or against the incorporation under the Revised Laws of 1905 of a Village to be named " Alice. "

The number of persons actually residing in said territory are two hundred and twenty-three (223), as has been duly ascertained by a census taken under our direction on the 24th day of January, 1910, as appears by the verification hereto.
