P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS there was conducted in Minnesota in 1935 a campaign of such effectiveness that September traffic accident deaths and injuries were materially lower than in the preceding year; and

WHEREAS the possibility for reduction in deaths and injuries from motor vehicle mishaps by coordinated efforts was so demonstrated;

I, THEREFORE, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, hereby proclaim the Month of September, next following, as "Minnesota Safety Month", and call upon the Minnesota Public Safety Committee to initiate and sponsor such efforts and activities as may serve to enlist the active cooperation of all citizens for still greater reduction of traffic deaths and injuries, particularly during the month of September, but, as well, for all succeeding months.

I urge and request of all the departments of state, all courts of jurisdiction, all county and municipal officers, and others in authority, full cooperation toward making Minnesota the safest state, and particularly toward changing September from the month of high traffic accident scores to the lowest.
