Arnold L. Fredricksen, having been first duly sworn, on his oath doth depose and say that he resides at Dilworth, Minnesota; that on the 21st day of April, 1936, there was filed with the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota, a certificate under the hands of Elmer J. Ryan and John P. Erickson, as Chairman and Secretary, respectively, of the Democratic State Convention of the State of Minnesota, reciting the nomination by said convention, at its session held at Mankato, Minnesota, on February 1st, 1936, of eleven persons therein named, among them affiant, as the Candidates of the Democratic Party of the State of Minnesota for Presidential Electors of the State of Minnesota, at the 1936 General Election. That as the result thereof affiant is one of the ~~2~~ Nominees of the Democratic Party for Presidential Elector at the 1936 General Election.

That I make this affidavit to the Secretary of State for the purpose of requesting that my name as candidate for the office of Presidential Elector be NOT printed upon the General Election ballot to be used on the 3rd day of November, 1936, and that I hereby withdraw as a candidate for said office.

Affiant further says that he withdraws as such candidate for the reason that he is advised, and verily believes, that he is ineligible to serve as a presidential elector, if elected, for the reason that he holds an office of trust and profit under the United States.

Affiant further says that he does so withdraw as such candidate in favor of Dr. J. A. Roy of Red Lake Falls, Minnesota, who has heretofore been nominated by the property party committee to fill the vacancy caused by affiant's said ineligibility.
