Whereas, I, Arthur Peterson, Governor of Minnesota, do
hereby declare

ARTICLE, SECTION 10, 1917

as

LEGISLATIVE ACT, 1917

and may be observed by the people of this State, with such
ceremonies as may be deemed appropriate and I also request public
officials and people generally to display the flag of the United
States on that day.
