WHEREAS, special legislation must be passed by the Legislature of Minnesota in order that the people of this State may avail themselves of the benefits of that Act, and


WHEREAS, such legislation must be enacted before the next regular session of the Minnesota Legislature, and

WHEREAS, the State of Minnesota may suffer financial loss amounting to upward of \$3,000,000 in the event that said Special Session is not called,


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Hjalmar Petersen, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby summon the members of the Legislature to convene in extra session on
