


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I, WILLIAM S. ERVIN, Attorney General of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by statute, and particularly by authority of Section 114, Mason's Minnesota Statutes for 1927, do hereby constitute and appoint LOUIS B. BRECHET, of Hector, Minnesota, as a Special Assistant Attorney General for the Commissioner of Highways, and I hereby fix his compensation in the sum of Three Hundred Thirty Three Dollars and thirty-three cents (\$333.33) per month, to be paid from and out of the Trunk Highway Fund. Said appointment to commence on January 1, 1937, and to serve at the pleasure of the Attorney General and until this commission shall be revoked or otherwise terminated in accordance with law.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand at St. Paul, Minnesota, this fourth day of January, 1937.


