

Under and by virtue of the provisions of Chapter 202, Laws 1911, I, William S. Ervin, the duly appointed, qualified and acting Attorney General of the State of Minnesota do hereby appoint and designate Harry W. Oehler, one of the Assistant Attorney Generals of the State of Minnesota as "Assistant Attorney General in Charge of Inheritance Tax Matters," to have and exercise all the rights, powers and privileges conferred on the Attorney General by the provisions of said Chapter 202, Laws 1911, and acts amendatory thereto, if any, and all the duties and obligations imposed in said act and amendments upon the Attorney General in matters relating to inheritance tax matters.
