ORDINANCE NO. 74

An Ordinance Providing for Extending the Boundaries of the Village of Walker to Include Certain Land Heretofore Acquired by Said Village for a Public Park.

The Village Council of the Village of Walker, do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the village boundaries of the Village of Walker be and they hereby are extended to include the following described tract of land, to-wit: All the unplatted portion of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter (SE 1/4 of SE 1/4) of Section Twenty-two (22), Township One hundred forty-two (142), Range Thirty-one (31), lying west of the line which is a straight continuation in a southerly direction of the western line of Fourth Street in Kinkele's Addition to Walker and lying south and southwesterly of said Kinkele's Addition to Walker; which tract abuts upon said village and has heretofore been acquired by said village for a public park.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication and the filing of a certified copy thereof with the Secretary of State of Minnesota.

Robert A. Oliver being duly sworn deposes and says that he now is and during all the times hereinafter mentioned has been one of the publishers or printers in charge of The Cass County Pioneer, a weekly newspaper, printed and published in the village of Walker, in said Cass County, State of Minnesota, on Wednesday of each week:

That he has knowledge of the facts and knows personally that the printed Ordinance No. 74 hereto attached, out from the columns of said newspaper, was inserted, printed and published in said newspaper once in each week for one weeks, and that all of said publications were made in the English language.

That said notice was first inserted, printed and published on Wednesday, the 7th day of April, 1937, and was printed and published in said newspaper on each and every Wednesday thereafter until and including Wednesday, the day of 1937.

That during all the times aforesaid, said newspaper was qualified as a medium of official and legal publications as required by sections 3 and 4 of Chapter 474, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921, and that it has complied with all the requirements that constitute a legal newspaper as defined in said sections 3 and 4, to-wit: that for more than one year last past from the date

of the first publication of said Ordinance said newspaper has been

(1) Printed from the place from which it purports to be issued in the English language, and in column and sheet form equivalent in space to at least four pages, with five columns to the page, each seventeen and three quarters inches long.

(2) Issued once each week from a known office, established in such place for publication and equipped with skilled workmen and the necessary material for preparing and printing the same.

(3) Made up to contain general and local news, comment and miscellany, not wholly duplicating any other publication, and not entirely made up of patents, plate matter and advertisements, or any or either of them.

(4) Circulated in and near its place of publication to the extent of at least two hundred and forty copies regularly delivered to paying subscribers, and that prior to the date of the

first publication of said Ordinance the publisher or printer in charge of said newspaper having knowledge of the facts, filed in the office of the county Auditor of said county of Cass, State of Minnesota, an affidavit showing the name and location of said newspaper and the existence of conditions constituting its qualifications as a legal newspaper as required and set forth in section 3 of chapter 484, Session Laws of Minnesota, 1921.

That the following is a printed copy of the lower case alphabet from A to Z both inclusive, of the size and kind of type used in the composition, printing and publication of said legal advertisements hereunto attached, viz:

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR EXTENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE
OF WALKER TO INCLUDE CERTAIN LAND HERETOFORE ACQUIRED BY SAID
VILLAGE FOR A PUBLIC PARK.

The Village Council of the Village of Walker, do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. That the village boundaries of the Village of Walker be and they hereby are extended to include the following described tract of land, to-wit: All the unplatted portion of the Southeast quarter of the Southeast quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Twenty-two (22), Township One hundred forty-two (142), Range Thirty-one (31), lying west of the line which is a straight continuation in a southerly direction of the western line of Fourth Street in Kinkele's Addition to Walker and lying south and southwesterly of said Kinkele's Addition to Walker; which tract abuts upon said village and has heretofore been acquired by said village for a public park.
