I, S. W. Dennison, Mayor of the City of South Saint Paul, Dakota County, Minnesota, do hereby certify that the following proposed amendment to Section five (5), Chapter ten (10) of the City Charter of the City of South Saint Paul was duly submitted to the voters of said City at a special election and legally called for that purpose, which election was duly and legally held in the City of South Saint Paul, Minnesota on the 6th day of April 1937.

That said proposed amendment is as follows:--

"Provided, however, the council of the City of South Saint Paul by its own resolution and without an application of property owners, shall annually determine and order: what streets and roadways within said City of South Saint Paul shall be oiled; the character of and the manner in which the same shall be oiled; and provide for the payment thereof by general taxation in addition to the maximum tax limitation as now provided by said Charter. Provided, however, that the expenditures for such purpose, in any one year shall not exceed one mill on the dollar of the taxable valuation of said City.."

The provisions of this amendment shall be in force and effect from and after August 1, 1937.

All provisions in said Charter inconsistent herewith be and they hereby are repealed.

That there were cast at said election 3069 votes. That there were cast in favor of said proposed amendment 2025 votes. That there were cast against said proposed amendment 743 votes.

That more than three-fifths (3/5) of all the votes cast at said election were cast in favor of said proposed amendment.

I therefore certify that said amendment was duly ratified, carried and approved by the voters of said City of South Saint Paul, at said election and is part of the City Charter of said City of South Saint Paul, Minnesota.
