PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, the fiftieth Legislature adjourned without enacting a tax program for the next blennium and without passing needed appropriations for relief and education, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that a tax program be enacted which will balance the state's budget and reduce the heavy tax load which is now borne by real property, and

WHEREAS, unless such a tax program is enacted, it will be necessary to very sharply raise the millage rate on real property to the great detriment of a large part of our population,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer A. Benson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby summon the members of the Legislature to convene in extra session on

MONDAY, May 24, 1937, at 12 o'clock noon.
