

#### Petition For Election to Incorporate

#### The Village of Garrison.

We, the undersigned legal voters residing within the territory hereinafter described do hereby respectfully petition the County Board of the County of Crow Wing, Minnesota, to call an election for the purpose of determining the proposed incorporation of the village of Garrison, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter NINE, Mason's Minnesota Statutes of 1927.

The territory proposed to be incorporated consists of section Thirteen, in the township of Garrison. Said territory consists of certain territory which has been platted into blocks and lots and which is designated as "Midland", and it includes unplatted territory adjacent thereto and the First Addition to Midland.

All as set forth in more detail in exhibit "A" hereto attached and made a part hereof;

Said territory contains a resident population of more than one hundred and less than three thousand, to-wit: 149\_.

The quantity of land embraced in the proposed village is shown in a plat thereof which is submitted together with this petition.

The proposed name of the village shall be "Garrison".

The following real estate is proposed to be included in the village of Garrison, to-wit:

Government Lots ONE (1), TWO (2), THREE (3) and FOUR (4), the West Half of the Northwest Quarter ( $W_2^1$  of  $NW_4^1$ ) and the West half of the Southwest quarter ( $W_2^1$  of  $SW_4^1$ ) all in Section THIRTEEN (13) Township Forty-Four (44) North, Range Twenty-eight (28) west, also the Southeast quarter ( $SE_4^1$ ) of Northeast Quarter ( $NE_4^1$ ) and the Northeast quarter ( $NE_4^1$ ) of Southeast quarter ( $SE_4^1$ ) of section Fourteen (14) in township Forty-four (44) North, Range Twenty-eight (28) west, All in Crow Wing County and State of Minnesota.

That said described lands include a platted area, to-wit: The plat of Midland as shown of record in the office of the Register of Deeds in and for the county of Crow Wing, Minnesota. It also includes the Blue Goose Inn which is located in Government Lot 3, Sec. 13, township 44 N. Range 28 W. said county.
