

Petition for Incorporation of
the Village of Myrtle, Minnesota.

To the Board of County Commissioners of Freeborn County,

Minnesota:-

We, the undersigned voters and residents of the Village of Myrtle, in the Township of London, Freeborn County, Minnesota, hereby petition your Honorable Board to call an election in said Village of Myrtle to determine whether or not to incorporate as a Village the following described lands lying and being in said London Township in said County and State, to-wit:-

Commencing at the south west (SW) corner of the north west quarter of the north west quarter (NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of section seven (7), township one hundred and one (101), range nineteen (19), west of the fifth principal meridian (5th P.M.); thence due east to the south east (SE) corner of the north east quarter of the north west quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said section seven (7); thence due south along the east line of the south east quarter of the north west quarter (SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$) of said section seven (7) to the south line of the right-of-way of the Illinois Central Railroad (I.C.Rr.), as the same actually exists ever and across said section seven (7); thence northwesterly along said south line of said railroad right-of-way to the west line of said section seven (7); thence due north along the west line of said section seven (7) to the point of beginning.

A plat of said land is now on file in the office of the register of deeds of said Freeborn County, and recorded in Book "4" of Plate, on Page 137 thereof.

The number of actual residents of said Village of Myrtle within the territory above described on the 15th day of March, 1937, was 116.

The name of the proposed Village is "Village of Myrtle", and the undersigned pray that you proceed to fix an early date for the holding of an election on the question of said incorporation in order that the voters residing in said territory may vote thereon.

IN THE MATTER OF THE INCORPORATION OF THE
VILLAGE OF MYRTLE MINNESOTA

The above matter came on for hearing before the Board of County Commissioners of Freeborn County Minnesota on the 6th day of April 1937 upon a petition signed by 31 residents of the territory sought to be incorporated.

The County Board having examined said petition and finding that it contains the requisite number of signers and that it had attached thereto a certificate signed under oath by three of the signers thereof certifying that the resident population of said territory was on March 19th 1937 of the number of 116.

The following Resolution was offered by Commissioner Stensrud:

Be It Resolved by the County Board of Freeborn County Minnesota that the above petition be and hereby is approved and that an election be held according to law in said territory between the hours of 9 A.M. and 5 P.M. on the 1st day of May 1937 and that a copy of said petition and a Notice of the Time and Place of holding said election be posted in three conspicuous places in said territory all according to law, and that the following three persons, namely, John G. Walk, August E. Schilling and Jerome Cafourek, residents of said territory, be and ^{are} hereby appointed inspectors who shall act as judges of said election, and conduct the same, so far as practicable in accordance with laws regulating the election of town officers, said election to be held in the Myrtle Hall of London Township, Freeborn County Minnesota, the same being located ~~in~~ the territory proposed to be incorporated on Lots 8 and 9, Block 3, Myrtle Minnesota, all in accordance with the statutes of the State of Minnesota. That the County Auditor of said County be and hereby is directed to take whatever steps may be necessary under the law for the holding of said election.

The roll being called on the Resolution there were five yeas and no nays and so said Resolution was passed.
