

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE VILLAGE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF HIBBING SO AS TO INCLUDE THE WEST HALF (W $\frac{1}{2}$) OF SOUTHWEST QUARTER (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) OF SECTION 32 IN TOWNSHIP 58 NORTH, OF RANGE 20 WEST, IN ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

The Village Council of the Village of Hibbing DO
ORDAIN, as follows:

Section 1. The owners of the West half of the South-west quarter (W $\frac{1}{2}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Thirty-two (32) in Township Fifty-eight (58) North, of Range Twenty (20) West, St. Louis County, Minnesota, which land abuts upon the Village of Hibbing, having petitioned the Village Council of the Village of Hibbing to have said land included within said Village, it is ORDAINED that the Village boundaries of the Village of Hibbing be and they are hereby so extended as to include the said land within such boundaries.

Section 2. A copy of this Ordinance shall be forthwith certified by the proper village officers and filed with the Secretary of the State of Minnesota.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, *and publication*
