

RESOLUTION PASSED BY COUNTY BOARD
June 23, 1937

"WHEREAS, the State Conservation Commission has caused preliminary construction of a dam across Snake River in Pine County thereby causing the waters of said River to attain a higher water level than normal under all stages, and

"WHEREAS, the raising of thin water has caused a great deal of farm land and meadows adjacent to said river to be overflowed and made unproductive so that many farmers occupying these lands are now faced with a shortage of pasture and the destruction of hay crops thereby making it necessary to cut their upland crops in order to feed their live stock and

"WHEREAS, this will leave them without sufficient feed to maintain their herds during the coming winter.

"NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Pine County deplore the imposition on the farmers affected and ask that the agencies responsible for the illegal raising of these waters now provide feed or funds for the purchase of same to these stricken farmers so that they will not be faced with the inhuman aspect of seeing their live stock suffer during the coming winter.
