

The following resolution was introduced by Commissioner Yetter, who moved its adoption, which motion was seconded by Commissioner Nickelson, and upon vote being taken, was declared duly adopted, to-wit:

WHEREAS, the tax delinquency in and for the township of Jewett, township 45, range 24, Aitkin County, Minnesota, for the year of 1935, was and still is more than 60% of the taxes levied in said town of Jewett, Aitkin County, Minnesota, and

WHEREAS the town government of said town of Jewett, Aitkin County, Minnesota, appears to the Board of County Commissioners of said Aitkin County, Minnesota, to be unable to function as a town government, due to lack of funds and credit, and

WHEREAS, it appears to the Board of County Commissioners of Aitkin County, Minnesota, that it is advisable to have the town organization of said town of Jewett dissolved,

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the town of Jewett, township 45, range 24, Aitkin County, Minnesota, be and the same hereby is dissolved, and that the territory formerly comprising said town of Jewett, Aitkin County, Minnesota, be henceforth governed as unorganized territory of said Aitkin County, Minn.
