PLEASE TAKE NOTICE THAT the State of Minnesota, through its Adjutant General, will apply to the Commissioner of the General Land Office, Department of Interior, for the survey of those certain islands to-wit--


Islands lettered B, D, E, F, G, H and islands numbered 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 opposite Section 32 Twp. 131 N., Range 29 W., 5th P.M., Sections 4, 5, 9, 16 Twp. 130 N., Range 29 W., 5th P.M. and Sections 14, 15, 23, 25, 26, 36 Twp. 42, Range 32 W., 4th P. M.

said islands being situated in the Mississippi River adjacent to Camp Ripley Military Reservation, Minnesota.

The State of Minnesota in said application will contend that the said islands constitute public lands of the United States and subject to survey and disposition as such.

You are further notified and informed that any protest which you may desire to interpose against the allowance of said application for said survey is, by law and the regulations adopted pursuant thereto, required to be interposed and filed with the Commissioner of the General Land Office, Washington, D. C. within thirty days following service of this notice.
