BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Clerk is hereby instructed and authorized to send a certified copy of this resolution to Mike Holm, Secretary of State, with a request that such census be taken of Independent School District No. 21, St. Louis County, Minnesota, as soon as possible.
