AMENDMENT TO SECTION 97
CHAPTER 5 OF THE CHARTER
OF THE CITY OF VIRGINIA RELATING TO POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE CITY COUNCIL.
Section 97 of Chapter 5 of the
City Charter is amended by adding
thereto another section numbered
97-A as follows:
Section 97-A. The City Council
shall have the power by a majority vote of all of the members
thereof to acquire by purchase,
gift or condemnation, land for an
additional public community
building or buildings, to be used
for civic, social and recreational
purposes.
The city council shall have the
power, by a majority vote of all
of the members thereof, to erect
upon said land so acquired, or
upon any other land owned by the
city, an additional public community building or buildings to
be used for civic, social and recreational purposes, and to equip
and maintain said building or
buildings, and do any and all
things necessary and incidental
in connection with the erection,
operation, management and maintenance of said building or buildlngs so constructed.
The city council shall have the
power, by a majority vote of all
of the members thereof, to construct any additional hospitals or
additions to any hospitals, and do
anything necessary or incidental
in connection with the construction thereof.
The city council shall have the
power, by a majority vote of all
members thereof, to appropriate
money, create any liability or authorize the issuance of any bonds
of the city that may be necessary
to nurchase said land and-or to
construct any additional community building or buildings and-or to
construct any additional community building or buildings and-or to
construct any additional community building or buildings and-or to
construct any additional hospitals.
All provisions of the city charter
that are inconsistent with this
amendment are hereby repealed.

CERTIFICATE OF RATIFICATION OF A PRO-POSED AMENDMENT TO THE HOME RULE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF VIRGINIA, ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

I, Oscar Tamte, as Mayor of the City of Virginia, St. Louis Gounty, Minnesota, do hereby certify that the proposed amendment to the Home Rule Charter of the City of Virginia, hereto attached and hereby made a part hereof, as petitioned by the requisite number of voters of the City of Virginia, and as presented to me by the Charter Commission of said city, was, after being duly published according to law, submitted to the qualified voters of the City of Virginia at a Special Election held in said city on the 8th day of February, 1938, pursuant to notice of such election as required by law; that at said Special Election there were cast 6,312 votes; that of such number, 332 were unmarked ballots; that the number of affirmative votes necessary for the adoption of said proposed amendment was 3,588; that at said election the hereto attached amendment received 4,166 votes for adoption and 1,222 votes against adoption; that following the canvass of said votes as required by law, the City Council of the City of Virginia duly adopted on February 15th, 1938, a resolution declaring said proposed charter amendment duly adopted; that said resolution was presented to me as Mayor of said city on February 16th, 1938, and was approved and returned by me, as such Mayor, on February 21st, 1938, whereupon said resolution was duly published according to law.

That this certificate is made pursuant to the Constitution of the State of Minnesota and the statutes in such case made and provided.
