
SPECIAL MEETING WITH COMMISSIONERS PRESENT, MARTIN BECKER,
NEWMAN F. IRELAND, A. M. ANDERSON, C. J. PETTERSEN AND JOHN A. PETERSON.

The following resolution was, on motion, adopted by unanimous
vote of the Board:

WHEREAS, a petition of the voters and residents upon the land to
be embraced in the proposed incorporation of the Village of Aldrich,
Wadena County, Minnesota, as provided by Chapter 1111 Masons Minnesota
Statutes of 1927, was filed with the County Board on January 4th, 1938;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT the request of said petition
be granted and approved; That the date of election be set to take place
on the First day of March 1938; That said election shall take place in
the Spillane store building on the main street of Aldrich Townsite;
That A. E. Button, John Strom and Charles Link are hereby appointed
Inspectors who shall act as Judges of said election.



A PETITION TO THE COUNTY BOARD OF WACENA COUNTY
REQUESTING SAME BOARD TO CALL A ELECTION FOR
THE DETERMINATION OF AND PROPOSED INCORPORATION
OF THE VILLAGE OF ALDRICH, IN THE COUNTY OF
WACENA, MINNESOTA.

To the Board of County Commissioners of
Wacena County, Minnesota:

We, the undersigned, voters and residents upon the land to be embraced in the proposed incorporated Village of Aldrich, Wacena County, Minnesota, hereby petition and request that an election be called for the determination of such proposed incorporation, and fixing the time and place when and where the voters actually residing upon such land may vote for or against such incorporation.

I.

The name of the proposed village shall be "Aldrich", in the County of Wacena, and State of Minnesota.

II.

That we have caused a census to be taken of the residents population within such territory and such census is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "A", and consists of twelve (12) pages, and above a copy hereof; that said census is found to contain more than the required number of residents, as provided by Section 111, of Larson's Minnesota Statutes for 1937, to-wit: One hundred eighty-six (186) people; that said census was taken under the direction of the Petitioners herein on and between the 26th day of November, 1937, and the 1st day of December, 1937.

III.

That the boundaries of the territory to be embraced in such proposed Village are as follows: Commencing at the southwest corner of Section Thirty-five (35), in Township One Hundred Thirty-four (134) North, of Range Thirty-four (34) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, thence north on the section line approximately three-quarters of a mile to the northwest corner of the Southwest quarter of the Northwest quarter (SW₄ of NW₄) of said Section 35; thence east on the sixteenth line approximately three-quarters of a mile to the northeast corner of the Southwest quarter of the Northeast quarter (SW₄ of NE₄) of said Section 35; thence south along the sixteenth line two thousand four hundred ninety-nine (2499) feet to the point where said sixteenth line intersects the south line of the Northwest quarter right of way; thence in a westerly direction along the south line of said right of way to a point where said south line intersects the west line of the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter (NW₄ of SW₄) of said Section 35; thence south along the west line to the county line between Todd County and Wacena County; thence west along said

county line to the point of beginning; containing three hundred twelve (312) acres.

IV.

That part of said territory so embraced has been platted into lots and blocks, which plat has been duly certified to and has been on file in the office of the Register of Deeds of Wadena County for over thirty years last past; and in addition to said lots and blocks, it embraces unplattead territory adjoining the platted part, and which unplattead portion is so conditioned as properly to be subject to village government.

V.

That attached hereto and made a part of this Petition is a plat of the territory proposed to be embraced in said village, and duly certified to by Elmer Howard, a land surveyor of Wadena County, Minnesota.






