NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer A. Benson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby designate the week of


May 15th to 21st inclusive

That, thereafter, this deponent and said enumerators agreed in writing and under oath to perform their duties in connection with said census faithfully and impartially and under the direction of said secretary of state, as more fully appears from Exhibits _____, hereto attached and made a part hereof.

That between the dates of March 9th 1938 and March 21st, 1938, all of the inhabitants of said Independent School District No. 21 were personally interviewed by one of the _____ enumerators above mentioned, working under deponent's supervision;
