PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS, Minnesota is largely an agricultural state and derives a major portion of its farm income from the sales of livestock, and

WHEREAS, the maximum consumption of meat and meat products is essential in providing an adequate and healthful diet;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer A. Benson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of April 25th as

MEAT WEEK

and call upon the people of Minnesota to observe this week by using meat and meat products in as many forms as possible.

Further, I urge that through the cooperation of meat producers and meat dealers an educational program be carried on throughout the entire week for the purpose of acquainting the buying public with the necessity and importance of meat as a daily requisite of the diet.
