

20. PETITION AND COMPLAINT OF THE CITY OF AUSTIN AGAINST
COUNCIL, MINNESOTA

21. We, the undersigned, do hereby respectfully represent and show to the Mayor and Council Council of the City of Austin above named the following facts, to-wit:

That we are residents and legal voters of that portion of Crane's Addition in the Town of Lanesing, of the Recrangement of North Addition located in the Town of Lanesing, or at lot 2, Block 3, Edison Addition in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 30, Township 108, Range 18, located in the Town of Lanesing. That we desire to have the following property annexed to the City of Austin, Hennepin County, Minnesota, to-wit:

a. Block 4 of Crane's Addition located in the Town of Lanesing (that portion of Crane's Addition located in the Town of Lanesing lying north of the center line of Sullivan Street).

b. Blocks 1 and 2 of the Recrangement of North Addition, located in the Town of Lanesing.

c. Lot 2, Block 3, Edison Addition in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter, of Section 30, Township 108, Range 18, Town of Lanesing.

We do hereby petition and request that an election be called and held for the determination of such proposed annexation.

That territory proposed to be annexed to the City of Austin is bounded on the south by the center line of Sullivan Street, on the west by the center line of Oak Street and of Oak Street extended northward, on the north by the north line of lot 2, Block 3, of Edison Addition located in the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter of Section 30, Township 108, Range 18, and by the north line of Block 2 of the Recrangement of North Addition, and on the east by the west line of the right of way of the Chicago, Milwaukee, St. Paul, and Pacific Railway Company and by the east line of Cypress Street and Cypress Street extended northward. For purposes of reference, the plat of Crane's Addition in the Town of Lanesing, Hennepin County, Minnesota, appears of record in Book 4 of Plots, page 34, office of Register of Deeds, Hennepin County, Minnesota, and the plat of the Recrangement of North Addition located in the Town of Lanesing appears of record in Book 4 of Plots, page 35, office of Register of Deeds, Hennepin County, Minnesota, and the plat of Edison Addition is recorded in Book 3 of Plots, page 30, office of Register of Deeds, Hennepin County, Minnesota.

That the territory so proposed to be annexed contains approximately 10 acres of land.

That on the first day of February, 1889, a census of the inhabitants residing on the territory that is proposed to be annexed to the City of Austin was taken, from which it was found that there was 107 inhabitants residing in said territory.

Therefore, your petitioners request that the Mayor and Council Council of the City of Austin receive this petition and set a time and place for the holding of an election relative to the proposed annexation of the above-described property in accordance with statute.

RESOLUTION NO. 198

Relative to the annexation of a portion of
Crane's Addition, North Addition, and Moon
Addition, all located in the Town of Lanesing,
Mower County, Minnesota, to the City of Austin,
Mower County, Minnesota.

WHEREAS a verified petition signed by four of the legal
voters of the territory hereinabove described has been presented
to the Common Council of the City of Austin, requesting that a
special election be held to determine whether or not certain
portions of Crane's Addition, the North Addition,
and Moon Addition, all located in the Town of Lanesing, be an-
nexed to the City of Austin; and

WHEREAS the Common Council has examined said petition and
the territory proposed to be annexed to the City of Austin and
described therein, to-wit:

1. Block 6 of Crane's Addition located in the Town of
Lanesing, Mower County, Minnesota, (that portion of Crane's Addi-
tion located in said Town of Lanesing and lying north of the
center line of Sullivan Street);

a. Blocks 1 and 2 of the North Addition
located in the Town of Lanesing;

b. Lot 2, Block 2, Moon Addition located in the Town of
Lanesing;

all of the above-described property lying and being in Mower
County, Minnesota, and find that said territory includes, accord-
ing to the census duly taken, 107 inhabitants; that it comprises
approximately 10 acres of land; that said territory is not in-
cluded in any incorporated city or village and that no part of
said territory is more than one and one-half miles from the pre-
cious limits of the City of Austin, which it adjoins and lies
that said position correctly sets forth the boundaries of the
territory proposed to be annexed, the quantity of land embraced
therein, and the number of natural residents theron; and that
said position is in all respects in accordance with the statute.

BUT, BE IT RESOLVED by the Common Council of the
City of Austin that said position be and the same is hereby ap-
proved and placed upon file.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of said petition, to-
gether with a notice, a copy of which is hereto attached, shall
be posted in three public places within the land proposed to
be annexed as above described forwarrd.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that an election to determine whether
or not the said territory shall be annexed to the City of Austin
shall be held on the 1st day of March, 1898, at a place located
at No. 1108 Sullivan Street, Crane's Addition, located in the Town
of Lanesing (Lot 2, Block 2 of said Crane's Addition), and at
least not less than 10 nor more than 30 days after posting the
notice.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the following named inspectors,

Donald Clegg, George W. Johnson, and Otto Langbein (City Surveyor, Alumnato), who are residents of the territory proposed to be annexed, shall act as judges of election and conduct the same as far as practicable in accordance with the laws regulating the election of township officers. Only voters residing within the territory proposed to be annexed shall be entitled to vote. The ballot shall bear the words:

"FOR ANNEXATION, YES

NO

With a space after each of the two words, in one of which spaces the voter shall indicate his choice.

Immediately after such election, the inspectors shall canvass the ballots and forthwith make and file with the City Recorder of the City of Austin a certificate setting the time and place of holding said election, that they have canvassed the ballots cast thereon, and the number of ballots cast for and against said proposition. Said certificate shall be signed and verified by all of said inspectors, to the effect that the statements therein contained are true.

The form of notice to be attached to the petition will read as follows:

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on the 2nd day of March, 1908, at a house located at No. 1103 Sullivan Street in Grun's Addition located in the Town of Leasing, Hennepin County, Minnesota, (Lot 10, Block 4 of said Grun's Addition) an election will be held for the purpose of determining whether or not the following described portions of the Town of Leasing, Hennepin County, Minnesota, herein:

1. Block 4 of Grun's Addition located in the Town of Leasing, Hennepin County, Minnesota, (that portion of Grun's Addition located in said Town of Leasing and lying north of the center line of Sullivan Street);
2. Blocks 1 and 2 of the Rearrangement of North Addition located in the Town of Leasing;
3. Lot 8, Block 8, Union Addition located in the Town of Leasing;

together with the adjacent streets and alleys, shall be annexed to the City of Austin. Said polls shall open at 8 o'clock A. M. and close at 9 o'clock P. M. Only legal voters residing within the above territory proposed to be annexed shall be entitled to vote at said election. The inspectors who shall act as judges of said election are:



ORDINANCE NO. 875

Annering a portion of Crane's Addition located in the Town of Lansing, all of the Rearrangement of North Addition located in the Town of Lansing, and a portion of Edson Addition located in the Town of Lansing, to the City of Austin.

WHEREAS a verified petition was duly filed with the Common Council of the City of Austin, requesting that a special election be held to determine whether or not (1) Block 4 of Crane's Addition located in the Town of Lansing, Mower County, Minnesota (That portion of Crane's Addition located in said Town lying north of the center line of Sullivan Street); (2) Blocks 1 and 2 of the Rearrangement of North Addition located in the Town of Lansing; (3) Lot 2, Block 3, Edson Addition located in the Town of Lansing; all of the above-described property lying and being in Mower County, Minnesota, be annexed to the City of Austin; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to said petition, Resolution No. 1464 of the City of Austin was duly passed, providing the time and place of holding a special election and appointing inspectors to act as judges thereat; and

WHEREAS the inspectors have duly made report to the City Recorder of the City of Austin by certificate showing that said election was held March 22, 1938, and that at said election 35 resident electors voted in favor of annexation and 10 resident electors voted against the annexation;

NOW, THEREFORE, The Common Council of the City of Austin do ordain:

Section I. That the following property now located in the Town of Lansing, Mower County, Minnesota, is hereby annexed to and made a part of the City of Austin:

1. Block 4 of Crane's Addition located in the Town of Lansing (that portion of Crane's Addition located in the Town of Lansing lying north of the center line of Sullivan Street), which shall now be designated as Block 4 of Crane's Second Addition to the City of Austin.

2. Blocks 1 and 2 of the Rearrangement of North Addition located in the Town of Lansing, which shall now be designated as North Addition to the City of Austin, and the street between said blocks Nos. 1 and 2 shall be known as North Street.

3. Lot 2, Block 3, Edson Addition located in the Town of Lansing, which shall now be designated as Edson Addition to the City of Austin.

Section II. This ordinance shall go into full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication.


