ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE EXTENDING THE BOUNDARIES OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYER, CARVER COUNTY, MINNESOTA.

The Village Council of the Village of Mayer, Minnesota, do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. WHEREAS, said Village of Mayer, Minnesota, has heretofore acquired by purchase certain land for a public park, and said Village is now the owner of said land, which said land abuts upon such Village and is described as follows, to-wit:

beginning at a point 160 feet north and 699 feet west from the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of Section 1, Township 116 N. Range 26, W. Carver County, Minnesota, said point being on the north line of the Great Northern Railroad right of way; thence north along the west line of Lots 7 to 12 in Block 1 of Haueter's Addition to the Village of Mayer, Minnesota, a distance of 579.3 feet to the northwest corner of the tract of land now owned by Henry J. Hill, the place of beginning of the tract to be described; thence east 177.3 feet to the west line of the land of the Evangelical Lutheran Zion's Church of Mayer, Minnesota; thence north 100 feet; thence east 155.7 feet; thence north 464 feet to the southeast corner of the land owned by Common School District No. 73 of said Carver County, thence west 333 feet, thence south 564 feet to the place of beginning, containing 3.96 acres.

Section 2. That the village boundaries of said Village of Mayer, Minnesota, be and the same are hereby extended so as to include all of the land described in Section 1 hereof within said Village.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
