P R O C L A M A T I O N

WHEREAS, agriculture is Minnesota's basic industry, from which the State and a goodly portion of its population derive a fundamental income, and

WHEREAS, agriculture today faces, as one of its most serious problems, the threat of ever widening infringements from noxious weeds on its income, and

WHEREAS, indications so far in 1938 are that weed control is expanding in all sections of the State,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer A. Benson, Governor of Minnesota, hereby proclaim the week from

June 26th to July 2nd, 1938


as

WEED CONTROL WEEK


and call upon the people of Minnesota to cooperate in advancing control programs now set up in the counties of the state.

That the cooperative features of weed control may be stressed, I hereby request the various county boards of commissioners to supplement this proclamation with similar proclamations of county-wide nature.
