TO THE HONORABLE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF THE COUNTY OF POPE AND STATE OF MINNESOTA:

The undersigned voters and residents of the territory hereinafter described, desiring to organize a village under the provisions of Sections 1111 to 1117 inclusive, Mason's Minnesota Statutes for 1927, respectfully represent and show to your Honorable Board:

1. That the territory proposed to be incorporated as a village lies in the Town of Minnewaska, Fope County, Minnesota, and is more particularly described as follows, to wit:

All of Sections 22 and 15 and the South Half of Section 10 (Ten), All of Section Eleven (11) except the North Half of the Northwest Quarter (NS NWL) and the West Half of the South West Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (W2 SW2 NW2), all that part of the Southeast Quarter (SE2) of Section Two (2) which lies south of the right-of -way of the Northern Pacific Railway Company, all in Township One Hundred Twenty Five (125) Range (38); that the boundaties of said proposed Village are limited to and co-extensive with the boundaries of the territory above described, and that the quantity of land embraced within the said boundaries is 710.25 acres.
