
WHEREAS, this July toll is due largely to the huge Independence Day holiday death total; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Elmer A. Benson, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby call upon every citizen and visitor of the state to join enthusiastically and heartily in this nation-wide campaign for greater July and summer safety by using renewed and increased vigilance and caution while walking or driving and by not driving after drinking.
